SLIPPIN' 'N' SLIDIN'

This morsel came from musicianpaper.com's Hemme Luttjeboer, who says, "Here's a sweet melodic idea to help stretch a Dm7 chord by sliding up the neck, adding a few 9ths and 11ths along the way. The initial sus2 shape gives way to a familiar grip that slides up a fret. Slide back down again and target F (E#) on the second string (the minor 3rd of Dm7 or the #5 of A). The lick climaxes with a tension-producing Aaug#9 arpeggio with a root harmonic on the fourth string that creates a tasty cluster sound."
